



FINANCIAL POLICIES FOR CONSULTS *

- Our financial coordinators are readily available to meet with you personally to provide the specific information you desire. They specialize in this area and will use their expertise to help you.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- Payment for your office visit is due at the time of your appointment.

For insurance related cases, you will be responsible for your copayment.

For aesthetic cases, the \$100 consultation fee is due. This fee is applied toward the surgical expense if you schedule surgery within 30 days after your consultation.

CASH OR CHECK: Cash or personal check is accepted.

CREDIT CARDS: Visa, Master Card, Discover or American Express.

INSURANCE COVERAGE

- The benefits paid by insurance companies for plastic surgery vary greatly from carrier to carrier and plan to plan. Once you come in for your visit, we make every effort to determine in advance if insurance coverage exists. We will advise you of deductible and co-insurance that is applicable to your plan. We believe you need to be as informed as possible before surgery. You are ultimately responsible for the full payment of your account, but have found that our knowledge and experience can be an important factor in assisting you to collect your maximum benefits.

CARE CREDIT: Applications can be taken in person, with the Patient Coordinator, by phone at (800)365-8295 or online at www.carecredit.com.

- NOTE: Once you come in for your consultation, if you decide to proceed with scheduling surgery, a \$1000 deposit is required to reserve your surgery date if it is an aesthetic procedure(s). The remaining payment for cosmetic plastic surgery is not due until 4 weeks prior to surgery date.
